



COVID-19 CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALL VISITORS TO OUR RESORT

You and everyone in your group agree to obey this Code of Conduct while at our resort.

Clarification of Terminology:

- Households are comprised of adults and children who live in the same family home.
- Groups - The current government policy is that each group must be from one household but can include a second close household, such as children and grandchildren.
Note: The Canadian and BC Government rules regarding gathering in groups are fluid and may change. In the case where our Code of Conduct differs from that of the BC or Canadian Governments, the government rules in effect at that time shall apply.
- Social Distancing: keeping at least 2 meters apart. The current government sanctioned rules are that social distancing does not apply to households or groups.
- Safety Measures: includes washing your hands with soap and warm water or disinfecting hand wash, and disinfecting any surfaces that have been touched by others.
- Covid-19 Symptoms: includes cough, fever, fatigue, sore throat, shortness of breath , and any other symptoms added by government agencies monitoring this health situation.

The following is to be applicable at the time of your reservation date:

1. You certify that no one in your household has been diagnosed with, is showing, or has shown symptoms of COVID-19 as defined by government authorities within the last 14 days prior to your arrival.
2. You certify that you have not knowingly come into contact with anyone who is showing, or has shown symptoms of COVID-19 within the last 14 days prior to your reservation date.
3. You certify that you have not travelled out of Canada, nor have knowingly come into contact with anyone who has travelled out of Canada, within the last 14 days prior to your arrival.
4. All resort visitors, including children, must keep to social distancing measures, with the exceptions being households or groups as defined above.
5. If you leave our resort, you must ensure to apply current safety measures upon your return.
6. Please be kind to everyone – if you see someone who is outside their household or group and who is not practicing safe distancing, please simply remind them in a non-confrontational manner – we are all in this together!
